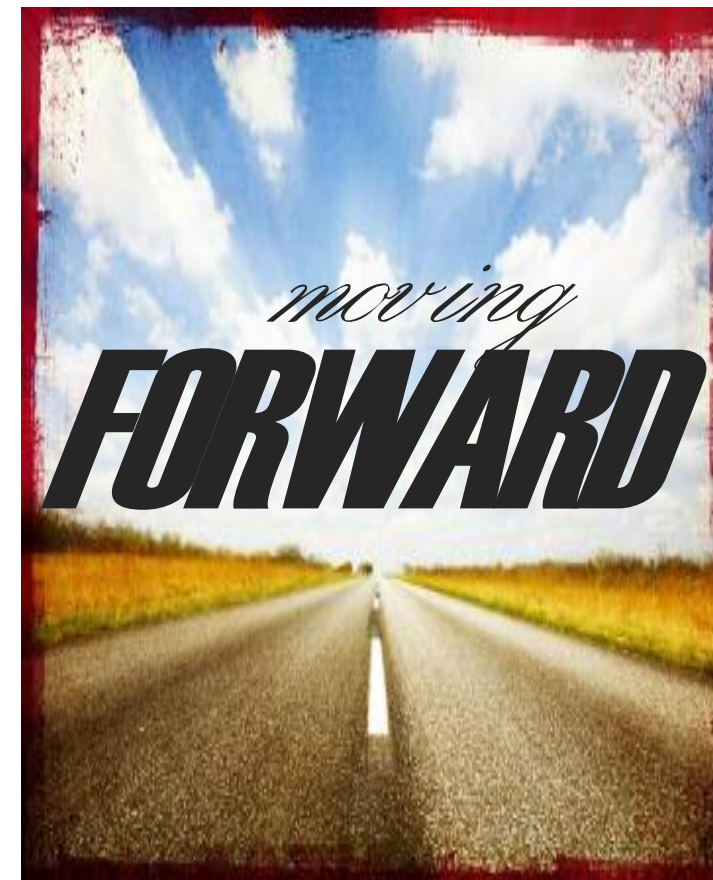

As God told Israel in Deut. 1:6 and 2:3 you have been here long enough. Every-

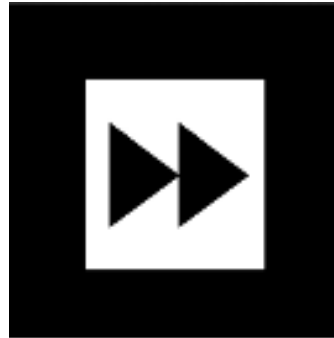
